A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE, TO APPROVE GRANT AMENDMENT ONE FROM THE TENNESSEE HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE (THSO GRANT) CONTRACT NUMBER Z26THSO11.

WHEREAS Agency tracking number 34901-01621 and contract number Z26THSO11;
and

WHEREAS the state has reduced the THSO grant (Tennessee Highway Safety Office)
by 20% due to funding cuts; and

WHEREAS the original budget was \$ 18,000.00 (eighteen thousand dollars) and is
now reduced to \$ 14,000.00 (fourteen thousand dollars).


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND

approves the grant amendment from the Tennessee highway safety office (THSO)
reducing the amount of funding the city will receive.

1. The Town of Ashland City has received a Grant Amendment for the THSO
(Tennessee Highway Safety Office) reducing the funding from \$ 18,000.00 (eighteen
thousand dollars) to \$ 14,000.00 (fourteen thousand dollars).
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this
grant amendment on behalf of the Town of Ashland City.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**AMENDMENT ONE (01)
OF GRANT CONTRACT Z26THS011**

This Grant Contract Amendment is made and entered by and between the State of Tennessee, Department of Safety and Homeland Security, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and Ashland City Police Department, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee." It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract is hereby amended as follows:

1. Grant Contract section C.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - C.1 Maximum Liability. In no event shall the maximum liability of the State under this Grant Contract exceed Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$14,400.00) ("Maximum Liability"). The Grant Budget, attached and incorporated hereto as Attachment One, shall constitute the maximum amount due the Grantee under this Grant Contract. The Grant Budget line-items include, but are not limited to, all applicable taxes, fees, overhead, and all other direct and indirect costs incurred or to be incurred by the Grantee.
2. Grant Contract Attachment One is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new Attachment One attached hereto.
3. Grant Contract Attachment Two is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the new Attachment Two attached hereto.

Required Approvals. The State is not bound by this Amendment until it is signed by the contract parties and approved by appropriate officials in accordance with applicable Tennessee laws and regulations (depending upon the specifics of this contract, said officials may include, but are not limited to, the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, the Commissioner of Human Resources, and the Comptroller of the Treasury).

Amendment Effective Date. The revisions set forth herein shall be effective once all required approvals are obtained. All other terms and conditions of this Grant Contract not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
