

Special Called Meeting of the

Board of Mayor and Council

September 22, 2011

The Board of Mayor and Council met in a special called meeting on September 22, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. in Fire Station II.

Present and presiding: Mayor Gary Norwood.

Council present: Alwilda Binkley, Jimmy Gill, Rick Johnson, James Yates, and Chris LaCrosse.

Council absent: Steve Allen.

Mayor Norwood called the meeting to order at 5:43 p.m. and let everyone know that the sole purpose of the meeting was to discuss redistricting of wards.

Sandy Cherry gave some information on population changes in the current wards that necessitates a review. Option I which had to do with moving Ashland Estates into another ward was discussed.

It was decided to go on to option 4 which will put all of Hidden Lakes into ward 3. Ward 2 will be a negative number leaving room for growth. Mayor Norwood stated with the new nursing facility to begin construction next year in that ward, and then when the Braxton begins occupancy, and the possible growth in the Hidden Lakes area this will add growth to all wards to be a good balance.

A motion was made by LaCrosse, seconded by Johnson to approve option 4 redistricting plan. Motion passed with a roll call vote of: Binkley-yes, Gill-yes, Norwood-yes, Johnson-yes, Yates-yes, and LaCrosse-yes.

A motion was made by Johnson, seconded by Gill to adjourn. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
