**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE ADOPTING THE  
CHEATHAM COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and


**WHEREAS**, Town of Ashland City participated jointly in the planning process with the other local units of government within the County to prepare the Hazard Mitigation Plan;
