

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER TO TRANSFER MONIES FROM ONE APPROPRIATION TO ANOTHER WITHIN THE SAME FUND

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City adopted the fiscal year 2017-2018 budget passage of ordinance number 469; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee State Constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the Tennessee Code Annotated section 6-56-209, the governing body has the authority by ordinance or resolution to authorize the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to grant the authority to the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1: The city recorder is hereby granted the authority to combine the monies from the general fund fire department budget and the general fund codes department budget.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
