**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR THE STAFFING FOR  
ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant will assist with staffing for a period of three years; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Ashland City acknowledges this grant is a 75% grant for the first two years and 35% for the third year; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Ashland City will be required to match 25% of this grant approximately in the amount of \$40,500 the first two years and \$105,300 for the third year totaling \$186,300; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Ashland City authorizes Mayor Richard Johnson or the Fire Chief to execute a contract, if selected, with the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE** that the Mayor or the Fire Chief be authorized to sign a grant contract with FEMA for the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant.


We, the undersigned City Council members, meeting in Regular Session on this 10th day of April, 2018 move the adoption of the above Resolution.


