RESOLUTION NO. 2018- 20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENDOR FEES FOR THE ACQUISTION OF
A RIGHT-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City currently has a water tank that is accessed by a public right of way owned by the Cheatham County Industrial Board which is located between parcel's known as Map 66, Parcel 46.07 and Map 66, Parcel 46.02. Said right of way is part of the original plat of the Industrial Development Board. Said right of way was never established as a County Road prior to the City's annexation although on the other side of State Highway 12 said right of way is known as Bluegrass Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the right of way is not to the City's road standard but has been used by the City for access to our water tank. The City would benefit from ownership of the right of way due to the water tank access and public utilities in said right of way and for possible new development in the Industrial Park on the Highway 12 corridor; and,

WHEREAS, the Cheatham County Industrial Board has voted to quitclaim said right of way to the City for a fee of \$500.00 to help defray their legal expenses for effectuating the conveyance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE, that the Town of Ashland City shall pay to the Cheatham County Industrial Board the sum of \$500.00 for the acquisition of the right of way as described herein.

We, the undersigned City Council members, meeting in Regular Session on this 10th day of April, 2018 move the adoption of the above Resolution.
