**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR THREE ASSISTANCE TO  
FIREFIGHTER GRANTS**

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighter Grant is intended to assist with vehicle acquisition, operations and firefighter safety equipment, and rehab unit; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Ashland City acknowledges the vehicle acquisition grant match will be 5% with a total estimated cost of \$950,000; and

WHEREAS, the operations and firefighter safety equipment grant match will be 5% with a total estimated cost of \$261,621; and

WHEREAS, the rehab unit grant match will be 10% with a total estimated cost of \$410,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE** that the fire department be authorized to apply for three with the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
