**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
ASHLAND CITY TO APPROVE APPLICATION WITH TDOT FOR STATE
INDUSTRIAL ACCESS PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, is vitally interested in the economic welfare of its citizens and wishes to provide the necessary leadership to enhance this area's capabilities for growth and development, and;

WHEREAS, the provision of jobs to area citizens by local industry is both necessary and vital to the economic well-being of the Town of Ashland City, and;

WHEREAS, the Industrial Highway Act of 1959 authorizes the Tennessee Department of Transportation to contract with cities and counties for the construction and maintenance of "Industrial Highways" to provide access to industrial areas and to facilitate the development and expansion of industry within the State of Tennessee, and;

WHEREAS, Caymas Boats plans to construct a boat manufacturing facility in the Town of Ashland City, and

WHEREAS, the construction of an industrial access road to serve said proposed facility is necessary and vital to the successful completion of this project and the future economic well-being of this area.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE** that a contract be entered into with the Tennessee Department of Transportation for assistance in construction and completion of the herein proposed industrial access highway under the provisions of the Industrial Highway Act of 1959.
