**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY TO APPROVE SUPPORT OF FISCAL
YEAR 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, funds are available through the State of Tennessee, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and,

WHEREAS, Town of Ashland City wishes to provide improvements to its sanitary sewer system for the benefit of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, Town of Ashland City may apply for CDBG funds in the amount of up to \$525,000 and will provide the local match funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE hereby authorize that application be made for CDBG funds to extend water lines to areas where public water is currently unavailable, and that Steve Allen, Mayor, be authorized to sign the application and all assurance necessary to filing said application.
