

RESOLUTION 2019- 06

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER TO TRANSFER MONIES FROM ONE
APPROPRIATION TO ANOTHER WITHIN THE SAME FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City adopted the fiscal year 2018-2019 budget by passage of Ordinance Number 502 on June 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee State Constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the Tennessee Code Annotated section 6-56-209, the governing body has the authority by ordinance or resolution to authorize the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to grant the authority to the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE the following:

SECTION 1: The city recorder is hereby granted the authority to transfer monies from the street budget to the parks department budget appropriations in the amount of \$17,200.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
