

ORDINANCE 125

AN ORDINANCE REDISTRICTING THE WARDS FOR THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, The Town of Ashland City has recently gone through an annexation of territory, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City wishes to change the existing voting district boundaries so that they are more uniform and equal in population with no more variance than plus or minus 10 percentage of population and in conformance with Bakker v. Carr and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City's charter provides under Section 4, "That the city shall be divided into three wards. Any existing Act or ordinance dividing the city into three wards shall continue in full force and effect until modified or changed as herein provided and authorized. The City Council may from time to time alter, modify or change the boundaries of existing wards, or designate new boundaries thereof, by ordinance duly enacted. The number of wards shall not be increased or decreased, nor shall the boundaries be changed within sixty days preceding an election" now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1 Ward 1 Boundaries. The boundaries of Ward 1 shall be as follows: From Main at Frey Street, south along Main to Forrest Street, Forrest to intersection of Bell on northeasterly on Bell Street to Frey, and south from the intersection of Main and Forrest to West McQuarry following By-Pass in a westerly direction across railroad in a direct line to Cumberland River (Cumberland Street or 49W & Frey on 49E). (Streets included are: Adkisson, Bell, Bluffview, Boyd, Brookhollow, By-Pass, Chestnut, Duke, Elizabeth, Fairview, Forrest, Gallaher St., Gloria Cir., Hale, Harris, Helen, Holloway Dr., Katye Ct., Lakeview Dr., Lowe, Marable, Miller Plaza, N. Poole, Rhea, So. Main, So. Vine, Stratton Blvd., Stratton Lake Rd., Tucker, Turner, VanHook Dr., Walnut, West Elm, West McQuarry, Willow)

SECTION 2 Ward 2 Boundaries. The boundaries of Ward 2 shall be as follows: Bounded on north with Ward 1 and continues along Forrest St. & Fairground Rd. southerly to Hwy. 12 S, following city limits to the Davidson County line and then thence following imaginary line in the center of Cumberland River back to the boundary of Ward 1. (Streets included are: Caldwell Rd., Clifton, East Elm, East McQuarry, Fairground Rd., Gallaher Rd., Graham Rd., Hibiscus Dr., Hickory Cir., Hwy. 12 So., Maple Dr., Marrowbone, Nashville Bridge Rd., Oliver Dr., Sandy Run Rd., Smith, So. Poole

St., Spring, Thompson Rd., Veteran's Rd.)

SECTION 3 Ward 3 Boundaries. The boundaries of Ward 3 shall be as follows: Bounded on south by Ward 1 and includes Cumberland Street (49W State Route) to intersection of Main and continues along Frey Street (State Route 49E) including Ashland Heights to the city limits, follows city limits on northern side of Town continuing back to City limit intersection on Cumberland Street. (Streets included are: Annette Dr., Ash Ct., Ashland Ct., Ashland Dr., Batson, Beech, Bowker, Brinkley, Cedar Ct., Court, Cumberland, Frey, Hillwood Cir., Hillwood Dr., Jefferson, Jupiter Ct., Lenox, Madison, Mars Ct., Mulberry, No. Main, No. Vine, Oak, Park, Ruth Dr., Saturn Ct., Skyview Dr., Sycamore, Valley View, Venus Ct., Washington, Water.)

SECTION 4 Date of Effect. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
