

Ordinance #132

An ordinance of the City of Ashland City, Tennessee, adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 1995 through June 30, 1996.

Be It Ordained by the City of Ashland City, that;

Section 1. A budget consisting of the available funds and appropriation listed in Section 2 and Section 3 below be adopted for fiscal year July 1, 1995 through June 30, 1996.

Section 2. The available funds for said budget are as follows:

Section 4. No appropriation listed above may be exceeded without appropriate ordinance action.

Section 5. A detailed, line-item financial plan shall be prepared in support of the budget.

Section 6. There is hereby levied a property tax of \$0.70 per \$100 of assessed valuation for the purpose of funding general fund services.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with charter provisions upon final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
