ORDINANCE # 138

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE,  
ADOPTING A SEWER/WASTE WATER POLICY REJECTING THE USE OF  
GRINDER PUMPS ON THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND  
CITY, TENNESSEE THAT:

Existing grinder pumps on the City's sewer system  
have been an expensive burden on the sewer system's budget  
which is funded by all users on the system, and

BE IT ORDAINED that there are other sanitary sewer  
products and devices that can serve both the City and the  
customers better and less expensively than the grinder pumps  
have been able to do in the past,

AND BE IT ALSO ORDAINED that it is now the City's policy to  
disallow any more grinder pumps on the sewer system, and as  
those grinder pumps in service today be replaced with other  
devices as they become defective.

This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days  
after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
