

Ordinance # 417

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES TO RE-ESTABLISH ESSENTIAL SERVICES FOR THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, the screw pump at the wastewater plant became inoperable and;

WHEREAS, without the use of a screw pump raw sewage would be compromised and become a possible environmental threat to the citizens of the Town of Ashland City as well as create other environmental hazards and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter the Council finds that it is necessary to allow expenditures not to exceed \$45,000 for a temporary pump until a permanent fix can be determined to re-establish essential services to the city's waste water plant. This is being done on an emergency basis due to the dire straits of the wastewater facility in Ashland City and to try to re-establish services,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE THAT:

The expenditures of an amount not to exceed \$45,000 is hereby approved for any expenditure related to re-establish essential service to the Town of Ashland City Wastewater Plant.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage the public welfare requiring it.


