

Ordinance #438

An ordinance of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee establishing a new position of employment as well as amending ordinance# 428 – 15/16 budget.

Whereas, the Mayor and Council realize the importance of and need for a Public Utility/Public Works Director to perform a variety of complex and difficult administrative, supervisory and professional work, coordinating and directing all activities of the Water utility and the public works department.

This position will have a salary of up to \$72,140 per year creating the need to amend the budget in the total amount of \$15,936 for the remainder of this budget year. Further that the open street department maintenance worker position will be done away with at this time.

This amendment in expenditures will be as follows:
