

Ordinance #463

An ordinance to accept a budget amendment for the 16/17 fiscal year.

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee is adopting a budget amendment for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize \$29,565.87 received from State of Tennessee for TEMA assistance with the 2015 flood recovery efforts and further appropriate this money to be spent in accordance,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize \$6,698.00 received from FEMA for the SAFER grant and appropriate these funds for the purpose of this grant,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize \$20,625.01 received from Cheatham County for the purpose of buying extrication tools and appropriate these funds for this purpose,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize funds of \$200,000 to be received from State of Tennessee in accordance with the HOME Federal Grant Program and further appropriate these funds once received in accordance with the grant program,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize funds to be spent for the Trail Connector Grant for the remainder of this fiscal year in the amount of \$100,000 and appropriate these funds accordingly,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize funds spent for the JAG Grant in the amount of \$15,000 and appropriate those funds in accordance with this grant,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize funds to be spent in the amount of \$974 for the TAEP Market Grant,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$5,000 for roof repairs to the Senior Center,

Section 1. A budget amendment consisting of the available funds and appropriations be adopted for the General Fund:
