

**Ordinance #467**

An ordinance to accept a budget amendment for the 16/17 fiscal year.

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee is adopting a budget amendment for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$52,255.00 in the general fund for salaries: \$23,960.00 for the Fire Department, \$20,635.00 for the Police Department, and \$7,660 for the Senior Center;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council appropriate \$52,568.00 in the general fund for the Tyler Project.;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize and appropriate \$4,800 received from the State of Tennessee for Fire Fighting Supplements;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize \$10,599.99 received from TML for lightening damage for the Parks Department;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize \$750.00 spent in engineering billed to Lee Batson for the Water and Sewer Department;

Section 1. A budget amendment consisting of the available funds and appropriations be adopted for the General Fund:
