

ORDINANCE # 529

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE TO ESTABLISH A HOTEL-MOTEL TAX

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Legislature recently amended Tennessee Code Annotated Title 67, Chapter 4, Part 14, [Section 67-4-1425] via Public Chapter 241 (HB0073/SB0858) at the request of the Town of Ashland City by Resolution #2019-04, dated March 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, said TCA amendment added a new subsection that allows the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, as situated in Cheatham County – to impose a hotel-motel tax “...upon the privilege of occupancy in any hotel located within the city of each transient in an amount not to exceed two and one half percent (2.5%) of the consideration charged by the operator.”; and


WHEREAS, in order to establish a hotel-motel tax for the Town of Ashland City in accordance with this TCA amendment:

- 1) This ordinance must be adopted with a 2/3 majority of the Town of Ashland City’s governing body,
- 2) All proceeds received by the city from such tax shall be dedicated solely for tourist development;
- 3) And the ordinance shall set forth the manner of collection and administration of the privilege tax.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE, that a two and one half percent (2.5%) hotel-motel tax shall be imposed; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
