

RESOLUTION 2020- 34

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE TO EXTEND RESOLUTION 2020-10: FAMILIES FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 2020-10 on May 12, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution was discussed at the regularly scheduled December 8, 2020 City Council Meeting as it is set to expire on December 31, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council voted to extend Resolution 2020-10 for sixty (60) days in order to allow the federal government time to deliberate changes to the families' medical leave act and the emergency paid sick leave act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that Resolution 2020-10 implementing a policy to ensure the Town's compliance with the Families First Coronavirus Response Act is extended sixty days and the provisions made therein shall expire at the later of sixty (60) days or the termination date for the provisions as provided by a later amendment or expansion of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

We, the undersigned City Council members, meeting in Regular Session on this 8th day of December, 2020 move the adoption of the above Resolution.
