

Resolution 2015-07

Whereas, the wastewater plant has suffered the loss of the screw pumps for the retrieval of wastewater at the beginning of the process of treatment;

Whereas, in the screw pumps have been removed and are being replaced with submergible pumps which are more efficient;

Whereas, the staff of the Town of Ashland City is installing the submergible pumps;

Whereas, all electrical work needs to be outsourced to a licensed electrician;

Whereas, this constitutes an emergency situation in that the Town cannot be without wastewater treatment for any length and period of time;

Whereas, the Town to effectuate the emergency has been renting trash pumps at an exorbitant rate and an added expense to the City;

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council have determined that this is an emergency situation and that there is not enough time to allow for bids for the electrical service;

Whereas, the wastewater plant lost, during the May 2010 flood, all technical drawings for the electrical system at the plant.

Whereas, Industrial Electric Service has completed work at the wastewater plant on numerous occasions and is familiar with the current system post flood.

Whereas, to begin this project with a new electrician would not be cost effective.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that it is in the town's best interest to waive bidding and approve the expenditure of not to exceed \$40,000.00 for electrical service to be contracted with Industrial Electric Service.
