

Resolution 2015-08

**Whereas**, the wastewater plant has suffered the loss of the screw pumps for the retrieval of wastewater at the beginning of the process of treatment;

**Whereas**, in the screw pumps have been removed and are being replaced with submergible pumps which are more efficient;

**Whereas**, the staff of the Town of Ashland City is installing the submergible pumps;

**Whereas**, this constitutes an emergency situation in that the Town cannot be without wastewater treatment for any length and period of time;

**Whereas**, the Town to effectuate the emergency has been renting trash pumps at an exorbitant rate and an added expense to the City;

**Whereas**, the Mayor and City Council have determined that this is an emergency situation and that there is not enough time to allow for bids for the pipe and fabricated metal;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee that it is in the town's best interest to waive bidding and approve the expenditure of not to exceed \$37,382 for pipe and fabricated metal from Consolidated Pipe & Supply Company and Pleasant View Manufacturing respectively.
