## **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER TO TRANSFER MONIES FROM ONE APPROPRIATION TO ANOTHER WITHIN THE SAME FUND

- WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City adopted the fiscal year 2016-2017 budget by passage of ordinance number 447 on June 28, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee State Constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the Tennessee Code Annotated section 6-56-209, the governing body has the authority by ordinance or resolution to authorize the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and
- WHEREAS, the governing body desires to grant the authority to the city recorder to transfer monies from one appropriation to another within the same fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1: The city recorder is hereby granted the authority to transfer monies from the general government and recorder's budget appropriations to the police department budget appropriations in the amount of \$4,500.00.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
