# TOWN OF ASHLAND CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES August 7, 2017

CALL TO ORDER at 5:30 PM by Chairman Melody Sleeper.

#### **ROLL CALL**

#### **CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Walker, seconded by Stinnett to approve the July minutes. Motion passed with one abstention from David Coode.

#### **PUBLIC FORUM**

Mr. David Lee stepped forward to ask about Leeland Station project surrounding his property. Further, he questioned the state the property is in and what the timetable for completion looks like. Chief Walker stated Mr. Batson has received approval through the planning commission, but has been stopped until a performance bond and licensed contractors are presented. Mr. Lee asked if there is a time limit on the approval. Chief Walker and Rick Gregory both agreed and stated the preliminary plan is good for one year; however, the developer can be asked to seed and straw to help with runoff. Mr. Coode suggested calling TDEC to investigate the property.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Request for rezone Graham Road/Hwy 12 R-1 to I-2. Brian Stinson presented a request for a re-zone of property at the corner of Graham Rd and Hwy 12 made by Cole Calligan. The property will be used for storage of trees. Mayor made a motion, seconded by Coode to approve for rezone and send to council. All voted yes to approve.
- B. Approval of Survey Map Hickory Circle. Brian Stinson presented a request for a minor subdivision map on Hickory Circle requested by Alex Evans. There was a question about the right of way being shown and the road not matching up with it. Mayor made a motion, seconded by Stinnett, to approve the map showing the new property lines staying within the right-of-way and not the existing road. All voted yes to approve.
- C. Rick Gregory Growth Discussion. Mr. Gregory gave a presentation on growth in Nashville and said he felt it would be helpful to share the information. Handouts were provided which discussed the cost of living in Nashville to be approximately \$70,000 to live comfortably, keeping the downtown area commercially viable, and online retail effects on business.
